CLUB HISTORY 1898-2024

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup.

Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match for Pat was held in July 2024.

Danny Ackland has now become the manager of Brockenhurst; we have retained many of the players from last year's positive campaign, and have made some great signings too. The future looks bright for The Badgers.



DOWNTON FO CLUB HISTORY

Downton Football Club was formed in September 1905, following a meeting which had been arranged by the Rev J.H. Phillips. Early results were not very encouraging. However, after World War I, in 1919 the Robins fared better after entering the Salisbury & District League.

The 1924/5 season saw Downton become the first winners of the Norman Court Cup. They also won the competition on eight further occasions before and after World War II. Downton won the Wilts Junior Cup for the first time in 1949/50, defeating Atworth 6-2 in the final. The following season, the club entered the Bournemouth League and gained promotion to Division One, winning the championship five times. The 1958/9 season saw them secure promotion to Senior Division One, winning the title seven times between 1959/60 and 1967/8. Downton also won the Bournemouth Senior Cup in 1962/3 and 1979/80 and the Senior League Cup in 1961/2, 1963/4 and 1966/7.

1979/80 and the Senior League Cup in 1961/2, 1963/4 and 1966/7. In order to progress further, Downton joined the Hampshire League in 1968/9, winning promotion in 1971/2. More promotions followed in 1978/9 and 1979/80.

In 1992/3, The Robins were elected to the Wessex League – the club's reserves joining its Combination League. The 1995/6 campaign proved one of the club's best ever – winning both the Wessex League Cup and the Russell Cotes Cup, while its reserves finished runners-up in the Combination Cup. They also entered the FA Vase for the first time.

The club entered the FA Cup for the first time in 1997/8. Downton enjoyed county success in the Wilts Senior Cup, winning it in 1979/80 and 1980/81, and finishing runners-up in 1955/6, 1991/2 and 1994/5.

Closer to home, The Robins lifted the Salisbury Hospital Cup in 2008/9, and retained the cup the following season.

The 2010/1 campaign was highly memorable. As well as securing promotion to the Premier Division after being crowned Division One champions in what was the league's 25th anniversary season, Downton also enjoyed their best ever run in the FA Vase, reaching the second round for the first time. A number of other accolades followed - Jeff Softley picked up the Manager of the Year honour at the league's 25th anniversary celebrations with four players – Charles Aldridge, Calum Robertson, Nick Turpin and Declan McGregor – all named in the Division One Team of the Year.

Downton finished 6th in their first year back in the Sydenhams Premier League, their highest finish to date. They also won the Hospital Cup again, winning 4-0 against Laverstock and Ford.

The Club were relegated back into Division One in 2013/4, having remained there since with a number of mid-table finishes. In 2017/8, the Youth section was added to the club, with four teams now playing under the Downton badge, ranging from Under 12's to Under 18's. The club remains committed to building a Senior and Youth squad for the area to be proud of, with the aim of having a full range of 10 youth clubs over the next few years. In the 2021-22 season the Robins won the Wiltshire Cup Final with a 2-0 win over local rivals Bemerton Heath Harlequin's . This is the 3rd time the club has won the prestigious cup. The Robins retained the Wiltshire Senior Cup (4th time in the clubs history) in the 2022-23 season with a 6-2 win over Wroughton.

Downton reached the playoff final of the Wessex league Division One in the 2023/4 season but were defeated by Millbrook, however the Robins were promoted only a few weeks later due to having the highest points per game ratio. The club also retained the Wiltshire Senior Cup for a third successive season, winning it five times overall.

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BLACKFIELD & LANGLEY V BROCKENHURST —21 DECEMBER 2024

Brock started this game positively enough – a couple of great runs from Bunce, one leading to a pass inside to Atiako-Hall who missed his kick – but the Watersiders also forced some sharp defending from Torniainen, just ahead of Roocroft, a reminder that possession and territory are only as good as the use you make of them. And on 17, Brock made the best use possible – a great chipped pass which Burgess ran onto and coolly lobbed keeper Harwood to give the visitors the lead. Atiako-Hall was almost in three minutes later, excellently intercepted by the impressive Hill... and then another warning shot, Bunce slipped in midfield conceding possession to Hitchings who advanced and shot just wide from 25 yards with Valero beaten. 32 minutes, free kick taken by Ramos, brilliantly tipped over by Valero for a corner... and before it was taken a red card shown to Pickett who - not for the first time in his career - had grabbed a Brock defender by the unmentionables. Down to ten, it was going to be tough for Blackfield, and they might have conceded a second to Bunce whose shot was brilliantly blocked. But then, game on: Brock lost the ball to Roocroft but he had an awful lot to do, which he did superbly, twisting his way past two defenders and shooting calmly into the far corner for the equaliser. It hadn't been coming, but now the hosts had something to build on. Bunce again – the spark of most good things – set up Torniainen whose shot was blocked on the line, and then Atiako-Hall seemed to be through but cut inside and saw his shot blocked. HT 1-1

There's not time or space in this report to list all the chances in the second half. 50 minutes, a Bunce shot blocked on the line; a minute later, his powerful cross was turned home by a defender ahead of Atiako-Hall for an own goal. The home team almost equalised when a free kick was deflected against his own bar by a Brock defender, but after that Brock created no fewer than eight gilt-edged chances to extend their lead, none taken – massive credit to Harwood who made some outstanding saves, mostly from sub Simpson, a couple more superb clearances off the line, and all that meant that the Watersiders held out hope of an unlikely point, especially when Reynolds came on and started racing down the right flank and crossing dangerously. Nervy closing moments, then, but Brock held out for the win. FT 1-2


