CLUB HISTORY 1898-2024

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup.

Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match for Pat was held in July 2024.

Danny Ackland has now become the manager of Brockenhurst; we have retained many of the players from last year's positive campaign, and have made some great signings too. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

TOTTON & ELING CLUB HISTORY

The Club was formed in 1925 as Bramtoco FC from the workforce of the British American Tobacco Company and changed its name to BAT Sports in 1971, the same year as we entered the Hampshire League. We progressed through the Leagues, winning Division Two in 1975 and being Champions of Division One in both 1988 and 1989.

In 1989 we installed floodlights, constructed a small stand and put a permanent fixed barrier around the pitch which enabled us to join the Wessex League. An additional stand and covered standing area followed in due course. Since joining the League we have twice reached the 3rd Round of the FA Vase, on the second occasion being drawn against AFC Wimbledon. With the weather causing the BAT ground to be unfit the tie was switched to South West London drawing an attendance of nearly 3000.

Due to the imminent loss of our Southern Gardens home we were forced to drop down a division at the end of the 2006-07 season and continued with our reserve side in Wessex League Division 2, at the end of that season and because of a restructuring in the leagues and still having our ground with a new one promised by Linden Homes we were put in Division 1 and changed our name to Totton and Eling Football Club.

We worked hard in getting a side that would compete and were eventually rewarded in 2008/09 season winning the Division 1 title easily with 100 points and a plus 90 goal difference to boot, regaining top flight Wessex Football again!

The following season 2009/10 was the year we moved to our new and present ground Millers Park at Little Testwood Farm which is adjacent to AFC Totton. We had a great season finishing 7th in the Premier Division and beating Gosport at their own ground in the Russell Cotes Cup final 3-1 after extra-time.

We managed to stay in the top division until 2014/15 season when with a lack of funds, having no clubhouse at the new ground to bring in extra revenue and a real lack of people to help out... the club got relegated. We did fight till the bitter end only actually getting relegated on the last day of the season and unfortunately no reprieve that year!

We have been rebuilding the club over the last few seasons with youth being our priority and we go again in Division 1 with our progressive development side in support and the backing of our Youth section that are the driving force at the club. We now have 11 youth sides and growing every year. The club has just recently signed a 25 year lease on our new ground Millers Park which now gives the club security and a stable footing to build for the future.

LAST TIME OUT

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BROCKENHURST V SHERBORNE TOWN—16 NOVEMBER 2024

This game was mostly pretty scrappy and disjointed, each side mustered a total of three attempts on target: but what counts is how many end up in the net, and Brock will definitely be happy with the three points. The visitors started the game OK: Cornish hit the top of the crossbar with a free kick on 14. But it was generally quite even, the Zebras were finding space down both flanks, while Brock tried to play a runner in behind the back line. But both sides were also too inaccurate – and then suddenly on 21 minutes, some real quality: a lovely Brock move getting the ball to Adams on the right wing, and his clever feet made space for the perfect cross, turned home at the near post by Simpson. Half-chances squandered, and then, five minutes from half-time, the first of a couple of "controversial" decisions. A Sherborne break, Wood racing down the touchline, Rhys Taylor blocked his run: referee Baines was the only person in the ground who saw this as an elbow to the face and a straight red. HT 1-0


Brock started the second half sitting guite deep and looking to play on the counter, coming under pressure but mostly handling it reasonably well – and then on 54 minutes, the second "controversial" decision, Walker taken out on the halfway line by Williams. He still had a lot to do, and there was a covering defender; the referee was possibly the only person in the ground who saw this as serious foul play and issued a second straight red. So 10 v 10, but the pattern of the game didn't change, and indeed the visitors started to create better openings. 63 minutes, a long free kick was headed back across goal and turned home by Murphy with his first touch since coming on. Inspired substitution? It could have got even better for Sherborne, because within 45 seconds Murphy was at it again, reaching the byline and seeing his near-post strike just turned wide by Valero. The Badgers now stirred themselves – an Adams piledriver excellently saved by Attwood; Adams again, finding space on the left, but tried to pass to Simpson when he might have taken it on himself. Time ticking by... and finally, when it seemed like the match was petering out, 87 minutes: Adams' free kick from the left was met by the brilliant darting run of Walker to head in at the near post, and the effort and patience were rewarded. 
