First I appreciate the work and effort outgoing chairman Chris Panayi put in over the previous three years and indeed all the previous committee I had the pleasure of working with during that time.



CLUB HISTORY 1898-2023

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup.

Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match for Pat was held in July 2024.

Danny Ackland has now become the manager of Brockenhurst; we have retained many of the players from last year's positive campaign, and have made some great signings too. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

HAMBLE CLUB CLUB HISTORY

More than one year has been traced for the formation of Hamble Club, but it is 1969 which is deemed to be correct.

Formed as Hamble FC, they made steady progress through the Southampton Junior League before merging with a Sunday team called Hamble Club and adopted their current name in 1981. From the senior divisions, Hamble Club were promoted to the Hampshire League in 1993. They moved from their old Mount Pleasant base to the old College Fields and made a further move to what was then known as the Shell-Max Ground during the 2002/03 season, which remains their present home.

Wessex members between 2004 and 2007, Hamble became Hampshire Premier League founders but failed to complete the 2012/13 season and had to start a division lower. This heralded the start of an upturn as they gained four promotions in five years, including one in their first season back in the Wessex League in 2017.

The Club was established in 1969, originally as a youth team. In 1993, they joined Division Three of the Hampshire League.

The Club were Division Three champions in 1996/97 earning promotion to Division Two. In 2004, the Hampshire League merged into the Wessex League, with Hamble becoming members of the new Division Three. In 2006 the division was renamed division Two but at the end of 2006/07, the division was disbanded and the club became founder members of the Hampshire Premier League.

Hamble pulled out of the Hampshire Premier League during the 2012/13 season. Although they were readmitted the following season, they started in the newly formed second tier of the League, division One. The Club were Division One runners-up in the 2013/14 season and were promoted to the senior division and went on to win the Senior Division in 2014/15. After finishing third the following season, they were promoted to Division One and then were Division One champions in 2016/17, earning promotion to the Premier Division.

LAST TIME ROUND

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BROCKENHURST V HAMBLE CLUB—10 OCTOBER 2023

Brockenhurst 1 Hamble Club 1

An entertaining, competitive and sometimes fractious game which ended all square – probably about right, because I reckon both sides will have been frustrated not to win, but both will have been aware that they could easily have lost it.

The Badgers started brightly, indeed the Monks were curiously subdued in the first half, and Brock largely dominated both possession and territory, but crosses were cut out and shots were blocked... on 24 minutes an excellent move, but Speechley-Price cleared the bar from about eight yards out. Pearce-Eavis hammered a shot from the edge of the box just wide on 35. Hamble Club had created a couple of chances, mostly through the outstanding Roach: one attempted lob which went into the keeper's arms, and later narrowly beaten to the ball by Mayo. But right on half time, the visitors snatched an unlikely lead. A free-kick was cleared, but returned to the edge of the box where Roach flicked a neat pass on to Douglas, whose clever finish beat Mayo and rolled gently into the far corner. HT 0-1 The Monks could have increased their advantage early in the second half: Roach hit a shot from a tight angle high and wide, and then a shot from range bouncing back off the crossbar. But the Badgers worked their way back into the game, with the Hamble tactic now seeming to be "just find Roach", and the home side levelled on 72 when another good Pearce-Eavis cross was headed home by Speechley-Price. Within a minute the home side could have been ahead, McCarthy-Gardiner with the cross this time, pulled back to the edge of the box but Shorey's shot whistled just wide. Ten minutes from time: Brad Johnson, aggrieved by an incident the officials (and I) didn't see, pushed Speechley-Price to the ground, getting a yellow card, but he was obviously hugely aggrieved because he kept on arguing and talked himself into a second yellow and with it an early bath. Deep into injury time Hamble hit the bar again, this time from a header, with the rebound blocked on the line by Moore; and there was still time for Choqogudza to go on a mazy run, beating several players before finally being tackled on the edge of the box. Worth mentioning that when Roach was substituted late on, he got a good round of applause from the home fans, not an accolade we have bestowed on an opponent very often! FT 1-1


