enjoy the fun!


Also on Friday 25th October at 6pm I will host our latest Members Update meeting and bring you all up to speed with what we've been doing in the 100 days since the AGM.

Wishing everyone an enjoyable afternoon and hoping to hear lots of noise for our boys.



CLUB HISTORY 1898-2024

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup.

Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match for Pat was held in July 2024.

Danny Ackland has now become the manager of Brockenhurst; we have retained many of the players from last year's positive campaign, and have made some great signings too. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

BLACKFIELD & LANGLEY CLUB HISTORY

The Watersiders were founded in 1935. After playing in the wartime Hythe and District League the club joined the Southampton Junior League. We joined the Hampshire League in 1950, winning Division One in 1998.

The club recognised that the longer-term aim had to be promotion to the Wessex League. Despite being champions of the Hampshire League, ground improvements necessary for promotion had not been completed. Finally in 2000, after 50 years in the Hampshire League, the Watersiders achieved promotion to the Wessex League.

In 2005 the club became only the second in Hampshire to be awarded the FA Adult Standard Charter.

By 2009 the club had achieved promotion to the Wessex Premier division. The 2012/13 season was a standout – the Watersiders won the Premier Division by 10 points, reached the 4th Qualifying round of the FA Cup, losing 3-0 to Hastings United, and reached the last 32 of the FA Vase.

The Watersiders were winners of the Russell-Cotes Cup in 2015.

Glenn Howes took the reins in his managerial debut in 2015/16, ultimately guiding the team to third place behind Salisbury FC, missing out on second place with a defeat at Fareham Town on the last game of the season. The club also finished runners up in the Southampton Senior Cup and in the Russell-Cotes Cup and made it to the 3rd round qualifying of the FA Cup.

2017/18 was the most successful in the club's history – as well as appearances in two finals at St Mary's, in the Hampshire Senior and Southampton Senior Cups, and reaching the last 32 in the FA Vase, the Watersiders won the Wessex Premier Division and were promoted to the Southern League.

Success continued in 2018/19 with the Club winning Southern League South Division One. Hard work behind the scenes in connection with Ground Grading requirements enabled the club to be promoted to the Southern League South Premier Division.

Over the years, the Club has had their fair share of Cup success. In the 1980/90s the Club made six appearances at the Dell in the Southampton Senior Cup to add to the two in the 1940s, ending up as winners in four of them. The last success, in 1998, led to a league and cup double. In the 2000 final, the Club suffered the agony of losing 2-1 in a replay to AC Delco (after a power failure caused the abandonment of the first game) with 15 minutes to go and with a 2-0 lead.

LAST TIME OUT

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BROCKENHURST V BISHOPS WALTHAM DYNAMOS –16, OCTOBER 2024

Lower league opposition, especially when you've not been in great form, always has the potential to be a banana-skin; but tonight that never looked likely. Bishop Waltham Dynamos from the Hampshire Premier were energetic and committed, but ultimately lacked the quality to overly trouble the hosts who ran out comfortable and deserved winners. Bishops Waltham started fast without calling into serious action, but Brock were already looking dangerous: Moreno blocked an attempted clearance and was unlucky that the keeper Connell, who had an excellent game, reacted quickly to turn his shot behind. Shortly after, Moreno was sent clear down the right and raced in on goal, only to sky his shot to groans from the stands. 20 minutes: neat interplay, guick feet, a sharp pass to Jake Adams in space on the six-yard line and he turned and found the net. Brock's first goal for 388 minutes! Five minutes later, a long through-ball from Oshitola, intelligent run from Adams, beat the keeper comfortably. 2-0... The Dynamos were working hard, and they put some good attacking moves together, but the final ball or shot let them down: Smith (twice) and Bailey Steele wide of the mark. HT 2-0 The visitors started the second half with renewed vigour, which might have been expected although the Badgers weren't necessarily ready for it. Losing possession in your own third is risky: 50 minutes, one such error resulted in a melee in which the Dynamos hit the post and then, just after, the crossbar. Valero was commanding under the high ball, which snuffed out other half-chances. But the visitors' attacking intent was allowing a lot of space for Brock to exploit, and they will have been frustrated not to have put the game to bed. While the defence stood firm, chances at the other end mounted: Connell made at least three decent saves, Adams and Moreno might both have converted from decent positions, some desperate defensive clearances - into injury time, a sharp pass, Adams clean through – but put his shot wide. And then finally, in the sixth minute of overtime, Brock won yet another throw high up the pitch, found Adams on the right-hand edge of the box and he hit a searing shot which lashed in off the far post to complete his hat-trick in the grand manner. It was no less than his all-round effort had deserved, and it wrapped up a comfortable victory. FT 3-0


