## ROGER LAWFORD

Roger Lawford first played for Brockenhurst Juniors as a young boy but in 1962 aged 12 he was asked to play for the adult 3rd team against Sway, he remembers Mick Lewis playing inside right and Pete Ansty being centre forward. Roger played on the right wing and he remembers scoring a goal from quite far out, he said 'it just floated in in the wind!' Bob Clark was playing for Sway and was marking him for the match. He was still playing for the Junior team and in the 1963/64 season they played Holbury Juniors in the final of the Magwick Cup. They won the match 4-2. He had trials at Bournemouth and Southampton but his Dad told him he needed to find a more stable and reliable job so in 1966 he started working at Wellworthys in Lymington.

Roger played his first season for the 1st team in 1967 aged 17. Other players on the team that season were Micky Reeves, B Ambrose, Pete Lewis, Dave Marsh, Steve Satherley, Bill Paramore, Mike Kimber, Barry May, Richard Pemberton, Brian Pardey and Bobby Stevens. One match he remembers playing against Alton Town in the FA

Amateur Cup. Brock went on to win the match 4-3 and Roger scored a hat trick! In subsequent years he replaced Malcy Reynard and Brian Marwood in the Amateur Cup games as those two players were paid to play and therefore not available for the team. In 1973 he went to play for Milford for one season but then came back to Brock in 1974 and played for the 2nd team when Brian Bidwell was the manager.

He took over as manager of the 2nd team, later becoming assistant manager of the 1st team. He continued to help out around the ground and remembers helping his Dad Jim with the upkeep of the pitch. He was a committee member and helped run the bar in the clubhouse on a Friday night. He became a trustee when he took over from his brother-in-law, Brian Bidwell when he became ill in 2004. Roger stepped down as a Trustee in 2024 due to failing health and sadly passed away on 24th February.

# CLUB HISTORY 1898-2024

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3<sup>rd</sup> qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6<sup>th</sup> in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup.

Brockenhurst celebrated its 125<sup>th</sup> season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match for Pat was held in July 2024.

Danny Ackland has now become the manager of Brockenhurst; we have retained many of the players from last year's positive campaign, and have made some great signings too. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

## WINCANTON TOWN CLUB HISTORY

Wincanton Town Football Club was founded in 1890 and played most of its football in the Yeovil and District Football League at Dancing Lane on West Hill. In the early to mid-1990's the West Hill ground was sold to fund Wincanton's new Sports ground development on Moor Lane to the south-west of the town. The club continues to play here still today.

Wincanton achieved double promotion from the Yeovil and District League Division 2 to become Premier Division champions in 1990/1. In 2002/03 the club were accepted for promotion into the Somerset County League. In 2006/7, the club made the decision to move over the border to play in the Dorset Senior League and were soon promoted into the Dorset Premier League.

In 2012/3 the club finished as runners-up to Portland United, allowing the club to apply for promotion to the Toolstation Western League. Wincanton also won the Somerset Senior Cup. The team finished its first season in the Western League in a creditable fourth scoring 116 goals along the way.

Season 2014/15 saw the club enter the FA Vase for the first time, with the club's first entry into the FA Cup coming the following season.

Season 2022/23 saw Wincanton reach the first qualifying round of the FA Cup for the first time in their history. Wincanton again qualified for the end of season play offs but lost 10-9 on penalties against Oldland Abbotonians. The season also saw the start of the Ladies section of the club with the side competing in Somerset League Division 2.

Season 2023/24 once more saw Wincanton reach the end of season play offs with a fourth-place finish. A dramatic semi-final with Wells City saw Town win an outstanding game 6-4. This set up a final at home to Brislington. A record crowd at Moor Lane saw Town storm into a 2-0 lead, but there was more play off heartbreak as Brislington battled back in the second half, winning promotion with a 90<sup>th</sup> minute goal. Two weeks later though the club received the surprise news from the F.A. that following their annual pyramid re-structuring process we were to be promoted to step five but also moved laterally into the Velocity Wessex League. We enjoyed our 11 years in the Western League, but very much look forward to visiting new places in the Wessex League and the challenge of step 5 football.

# LAST TIME OUT

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BROCKENHURST V  
COWES SPORTS — 04 MARCH 2025

Another disappointing night for the Badgers, as Cowes showed the gump-tion to grab the game and take all three points. Brock started positively, looking to play the ball in behind the Cowes back line, while the visitors were using the flanks and stretching the play. But it was the Badgers with the early breakthrough: one long pass forward to Bunce on the left, who shot calmly into the far corner on 6 minutes. He might have added a second with a powerful shot from 25 yards, helped over the bar by Hatt; and on 21, a quick break following a Cowes corner and Catley was forced into a last-ditch challenge on Atiako-Hall to stop him being clean through on goal. But 28 minutes, a Cowes corner, Wellman firmly challenged by Cook, McFarlane's shot through the crowd was well saved by Valero, but the rebound was bundled home by Tout-Walters. Goals change games: suddenly Brock seemed to slow things down and become more cautious... more importantly, Wellman had to go off after that challenge. The visitors might have considered themselves unlucky not to be ahead before half-time, because McFarlane had a free kick well saved by Valero, who then had to be alert to turn away another free header at the back post. And right on the whistle, Chase hit a fine shot which clipped the top of the bar. HT 1-1

The visitors looked more composed throughout the second half, and largely took control of the game, while the Badgers started to look frustrated. Long story short: Brock didn't have a shot on target in the second half, although Demira had a free header from a corner on 62 which he planted wide when he should have scored, and Atiako-Hall flicked a late header over the bar from a free-kick. But between those two moments, Cowes scored one and should probably have had more; Valero saved at the feet of Tout-Walters, but on 68 minutes a deep cross from the right, headed in unchallenged at the back post by Tout-Walters. Others might have followed – shots sliced inside the box, one deflected wide, one header away from his own line by Atiako-Hall, and nothing much was going the other way. Bunce was sin-binned with 12 minutes to go, which didn't help the cause... Phillips should have extended the advantage on 83 minutes but smashed the ball over, but apart from that one later header, Cowes didn't really have too many alarms as they saw it out for the points.
